*Education "Sit Ins"

Convention education sessions have been submitted for approval. You must attend the entire session and complete the required forms to receive CE credit. CE credits are electronically submitted directly to the LA DOI. Paper certificates will not be mailed unless requested. You may earn up to 13 hours of CE.

How to Dress

At most convention functions, anything you wish to wear is acceptable. We encourage you to come dressed in costume for our version of "Woodstock" as you wander the Exhibit Hall and other themed events. Otherwise, causal slacks or shorts and comfortable shoes are acceptable for the Exhibit Hall and all education sessions. 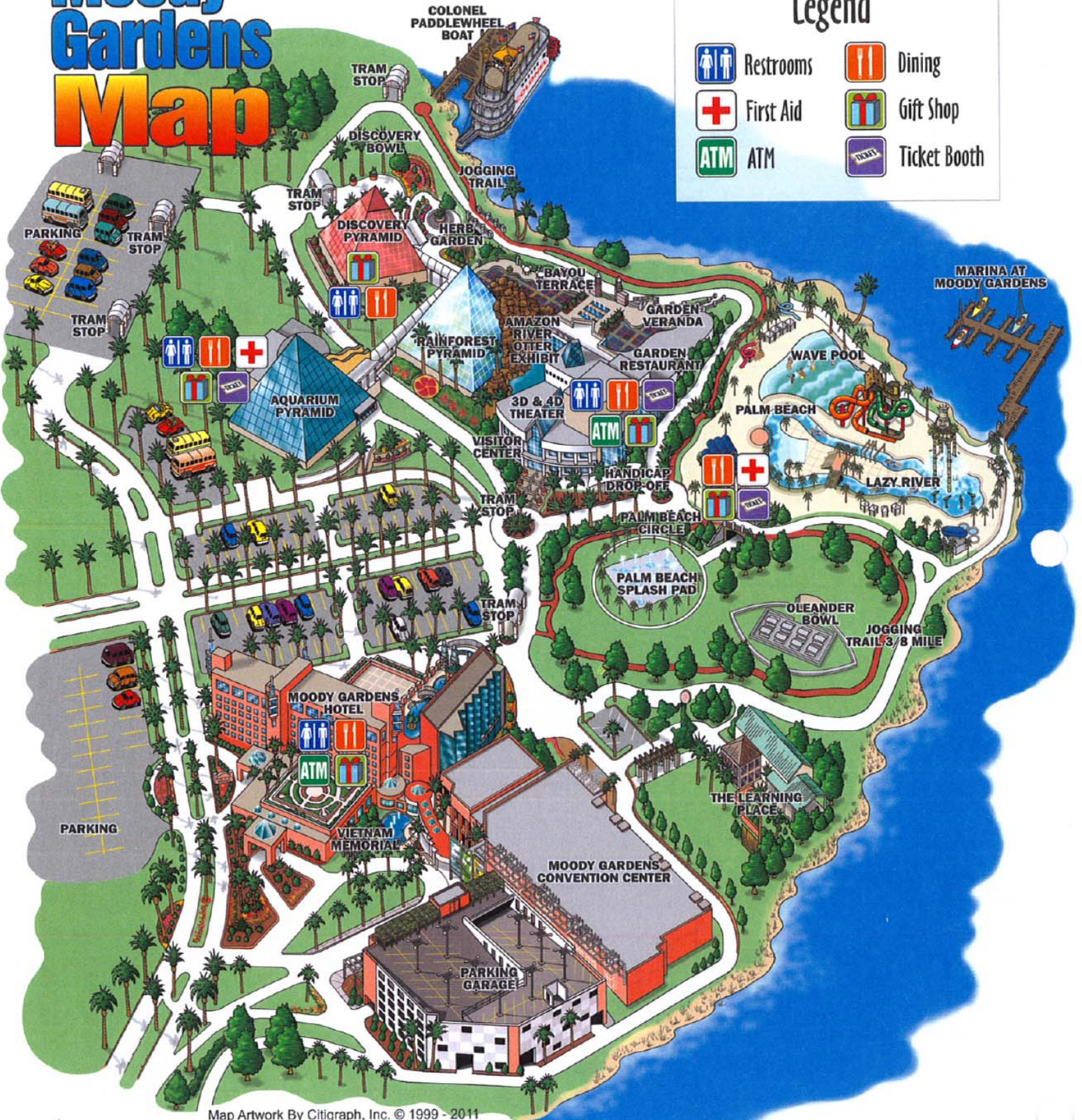
