All Convention education sessions have been approved by the LDOI. You must attend the entire session and complete the required forms to receive CE credit. CE credits are electronically submitted directly to the LA DOI. Paper certificates will not be mailed unless requested. 13 hours of CE are available.

How to Dress

At most convention functions, anything you wish to wear is acceptable. We encourage you to come dressed in costume as you wander our "James Bond" inspired "Q's Laboratory" Exhibit Hall and other themed events. 
